



## Multicultural Mentoring Program (SWaMMP)



Increasing diversity among wetland scientists is a priority of the Society of Wetland Scientists. Undergraduate students from underrepresented groups who are considering environmental careers are eligible for travel awards funded by the National Science Foundation and SWS regional chapters.
